Bluffton Lions continue to recycle. A load of batteries was taken recently to the recycling area by Lion Brandon Matthews and \$18.80 was added to the treasury.

Lion Ed Yeager took 23 pairs of hearing aids this week to the Findlay Hearing Center. They were extremely grateful and said they have a current backlog of hospice patients in need of hearing aids. It was one of those feel good moments for lions when what we are doing is appreciated.

Lion Barbara Plaugher took a large bag of crushed aluminum cans to the barn today and got home to find 2 more smaller bags at the back door. Continue to drop them off at my home on 62 Anna Circle since the red truck is temporarily not parking in front of the town hall. The last haul to the reclycling center amount to \$56.60.
