## APRIL 2<sup>ND</sup> MEETING:

Sheila Haney from the Regional Transit Authority in Lima was the speaker for this meeting.



There are 100,000 people in Allen County and the RTA has served 400,000 rides to this population. The RTA provides 6 fixed routes in Lima and surrounding townships for \$1. Also ADA services door to door for \$2. **Contract shuttles provide 19 small buses** for special needs. This would include an uplift van, overflow for VA in Dayton, all Allen county residents, Marimor school etc. In 2019 – 1,475 rides a month for Special needs students from 5 school districts and more than 1,000 worker rides a month. They have 50 employees and 30 vehicles. Funding for this service will be on the ballot.
