Bluffton Police Chief Ryan Burkholder spoke at the noon meeting of the Bluffton Lions. Chief Burkholder, a 15-year veteran of the police department, showed slides of his entire force which includes KATO the departmental dog. He spoke of the current training of A.L.I.C.E. going into the schools and preparing the children in case of a lockdown situation.

The department had 7,246 calls for service this past year. These would include calls for medical needs, fire, civil and domestic situations, house or building checks.
