BOARD REPORT:

New applicant, Jean Cook, has requested membership into the Bluffton Lions. Application accepted. Peace posters recognition was increased from 1^{st} \$15, 2^{nd} \$10, and 3^{rd} \$5 to the following: 1^{st} place will receive \$25; 2^{nd} place \$15; 3^{rd} place \$10. We continue to donate \$20 to the school for supplies used. 300 tickets for the new 50/50 charity raffle to be distributed by mail if the lion has not attended a meeting to receive their tickets in November. We will continue to pay out \$100 for 1^{st} number called; \$50 for the 2^{nd} ; \$30 for 3^{rd} ; and \$20 for 4^{th} . If all 300 tickets are sold there will be 2 \$500 pay-outs distributed one in spring and the other in the fall.

Dare to Dream report showed 150 in attendance with 173 tickets sold. A private donation of \$5,000 was received to go directly to the pathway project. Net from other income and expenses is \$22,484. 80% goes to the pathway project with 20% to be used for other community donations.
